William Webbe of Frittenden 1445

descended from Richard Webbe 1320 - probable direct ancestor of the Webbs of Gloucester.

Thomas Webb, the Duke's faithful secretary and friend, died in October, 1649, and was buried in Cobham Church. From the inscription to his memory on a stone in the chancel we learn that he was aged forty-nine at the time of his death, and that he had married Elizabeth Woodhouse, who died during the siege of Oxford.
