



WEBB OF MINCHINHAMPTON

Richard Webb = Margery

Died 1546 at Minchhampton
Witness to his will includes William Webb
the elder.

Richard may have been the brother of Edmund Webb of Bisley.
They almost certainly came from the Dursley/Wotton/Kingswood area of
of Gloucestershire and were related to the Wolworth alias Webbs of those places.

There was a Barnefield family in Minch. 1600
Church Warden of Rodborough 1560

to his eldest surviving infant son Richard together with all his lands in Minchinhampton, Rodmarton and Avening.

In the will of his father he is left various lands
